Nurse and Midwife Relocation Support

Help with moving and travel costs

If you're moving to start a new job with NT Health we will reimburse you for your travel and moving costs. What can be claimed and the amount reimbursed will depend on the length of your contract and where your job is located.

What we will reimburse

- Airfares, train fares, bus fares.
- Fuel expenses if driving.

ED

- Meal costs during travel.
- Overnight accommodation.
- Removal expenses for personal belongings, including furniture and one vehicle.

How much we will reimburse

Interstate Recruits:

Darwin and Palmerston - up to \$6,000

Katherine and Alice Springs - up to \$9,000

Tennant Creek - up to \$10,000

Gove and Remote Clinics - up to \$15,000 (depending on clinical/operational need, delegate may approve a higher amount).

International Recruits:

Darwin and Palmerston - up to \$10,000

Katherine and Alice Springs - up to \$15,000

Tennant Creek, Gove, and Remote Clinics - up to \$20,000 (depending on clinical/operational need, delegate may approve a higher amount).



Nurse and Midwife Relocation Support

Who can apply

Any nurse or midwife joining NT Health can apply for relocation support.

How to apply

You can submit a claim for relocation when you commence. You must provide all applicable receipts as evidence of expenditure.

Leaving NT Health

If you have an ongoing contract or a fixed-term contract greater than 12 months you may have to pay back all or some of your relocation costs if you leave NT Health within 12 months of starting your job.

How much you'll have to pay back

- Less than 6 months you'll have to pay back the whole amount.
- Between 6 and 9 months 65% of the amount.
- Between 9 and 12 months 35% of the amount.

You won't have to pay back any costs if you're leaving to retire or if you've been declared medically unfit.

Attraction and retention allowance

When you join NT Health, you might be eligible for up to \$9,000 over 2 years depending on where your job is located. You do not have to pay back the attraction or retention allowance.

Attraction allowance:

Payable after 3 months service Darwin and Palmerston - \$1,000 Katherine and Gove - \$1,000 Alice Springs and Tennant Creek - \$1,500 Remote Clinics - \$2,000

Retention allowance:

Payable after 12 and 24 months of service Darwin and Palmerston - \$1,500 Katherine and Gove - \$2,000 Alice Springs and Tennant Creek - \$3,000 Remote Clinics - \$3,500
